

Policy Name: Requirements to meet technical standards

PROCEDURE / REQUIREMENTS:

1. Demonstrate competency in handling emergencies using basic life support equipment and skills in accordance with the course objectives from U.S. DOT.
2. Verbal communication skills.
3. Hear spoken information from coworkers, patients, physicians, dispatchers, and sounds common to the emergency scene.
4. Lift, carry, and balance a minimum of 125 pounds alone, and equally distributed 250 pounds with assistance at the height of 33 inches, for a distance of 10 feet.
5. Demonstrate manual dexterity and fine motor skills, with ability to perform all movements needed for providing quality patient care.
6. Bend, stoop, crawl, and walk on uneven surfaces.
7. Meet vision requirements to operate a motor vehicle within the state.
8. Not be addicted to the use of any drugs or intoxicating substances.
9. It is recommended that all students' immunizations are up to date.
